4Kscore -test register

5 Essential definitions

'4Kscore -test' is a diagnostic blood test for finding out the risk of aggressive prostate cancer. The personal data of the participants forms a personal data register.

'Examinee' i.e. the data subject is the person participating in the 4Kscore -test.

6 Legal basis and purpose for processing personal data

The legal basis for the processing of personal data in connection with the 4Kscore -test register is the explicit consent of the examinee.

The purpose of processing personal data is carrying out the 4Kscore -test and the measures related to it listed below:

- blood test, which is used to find out the patients risk of aggressive prostate cancer
- finding out the need for further examinations such as MRI and tissue sample (biopsy)

7 What data do we process?

We process the following personal data of the examinee (data subject) in connection with the 4Kscore -test register:

Basic information on the examinee

- first and surname
- date of birth
- signature
- contact information: phone number, home address, email
- communication language

Information necessary for the execution of the 4Kscore test

- essential data for the 4Kscore test describing the state of health of the examinee, including information that the examinee is a patient of the Docrates Cancer Center and participates in the 4Kscore test
- data regarding previous samples, their analysis and the results of the prostate palpation test (digital information regarding the anus)
- blood sample and the four (4) different blood markers (fPSA, tPSA, iPSA and hK2 biomarker contents) received as a result from the 4Kscore test
- information regarding the administration of the 4Kscore test consents such as information on the retrieval of consent

Without the above listed data we cannot carry out the 4Kscore test.

8 From where do we receive data?

We receive data primarily from the examinee him-/herself. We also collect information necessary for the 4Kscore test describing the state of health of the examinee from Docrates Cancer Center's own patient register.

9 To whom do we disclose and transfer data, and do we transfer data outside the EU or EEA?

We disclose the register data to AS Kevelt (hereafter "Kevelt") who participates in the execution of the 4Kscore test. Kevelt acts as an independent controller and takes care of its obligations as a controller such as informing the data subjects.

Data is disclosed to Finnish Medicines Agency Fimea for research, planning, statistics and monitoring purposes as well as for reports of suspected adverse reactions and applications for special permits to acquire medicines with special

permit. The disclosures are done in accordance with the Finnish act on national healthcare personal data files (556/1989).

We use subcontractors, who process personal data on behalf of us. For the administration of the register's personal data we use a service provider, on whose administered and secured servers the personal data is stored and via it is transferred to Kevelt for partial execution of the 4Kscore test.

Our subprocessors transfer personal data outside of the EU/EEA for purposes related to the execution of the 4Kscore test. We have taken care of the appropriate safety measures related to the transfer. We use the standard contractual clauses approved by the EU Commission.

10 How do we protect the data and for how long do we store them?

Only those of our employees, who due to their working duties are entitled to process personal data related to the register, have the right to use systems containing personal data. Each user has a personal username and password to the systems. The information is collected into databases that are protected by firewalls, passwords and other technical measures. The databases and backup copies of them are stored in locked premises and can be accessed only by certain pre-designated persons.

We store the personal data for as long as is necessary for the purpose of the processing. The results of the 4Kscore test become a part of Docrates Cancer Center's patient register, in which we store data based on the legislation for 12 years from the death of the patient or if it is unknown, for 120 years from the birth of the patient. There is a separate privacy notice for Docrates Cancer Center's patient register on Docrates Cancer Center's website.

We assess the necessity of storing the data on a regular basis taking into account the applicable laws and regulations. In addition, we take care of all reasonable measures to ensure that no incompatible, obsolete or inaccurate personal data are stored in the register taking into account the purpose of the processing. We rectify or erase such data without delay.

11 What are your rights as a data subject?

As a data subject, you have the right to receive information on the processing of your personal data. You have the right to inspect the personal data concerning yourself, the right to demand rectification or erasure of inaccurate, obsolete, unnecessary or illegal data. If you have an access to your own data, you may edit such data yourself.

Insofar as the processing is based on consent, you have the right to withdraw or change your consent. Withdrawing your consent does not affect the lawfulness of processing before the withdrawal of the consent.

As a data subject you also have the right to object or to demand restriction of the processing of your data and to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority of the processing of data. In addition, you have the right to object the processing, when it is related to direct marketing, at any time and free of charge.

12 Who can you contact?

All contacts and requests concerning this privacy notice must be submitted in writing or in person to the contact person named in section two (2).

13 Changes to the privacy notice

We will place all the amendments regarding the privacy notice visible on our website dated.
